**Devils Postpile National Monument (7600’) & Rainbow Fall (7400’)  
Afternoon- Mammoth Lakes area – TJ Lake via Lake George, (8992’-9352’)**

### **Wednesday, 9/4/24 Rock Creek, Little Lakes Valley area (9300’)**

### **Thursday, 9/5/24- Mammoth Lakes area- elevation 8000’ Easy Group –**

- 1) **Crystal Lake trail** -- (9003’-’9785’), 3.2 miles total - **Easy**
- 2) **Horseshoe Lake loop** (1.8 miles, 124’) – **Easy**  
**Duck Lake Pass Trail**, 9042’-10909’, 7 miles RT in  
and out from Mammoth Trail Head - **Harder**.  
Restroom at trailhead only.

Options: 1) **June Lake area trails** 2) **Bodie Historic State Park**  
3) **Bristlecone Pine Forest, Schulman Grove.**

#### **Going home!**

Unguided hikes/stops Options:

- 1) Via Yosemite NP route, **Saddlebag Lake Trail** ( 4-6 miles flat, 10-11,000’),  
**check seasonal ferry!**
- 2) Via Sonora Pass Route – a) **Mono Lake Visitor Center**, Lee Vining and  
surrounds, b) **Bodie State Park**, c) **Lundy Canyon trail** – 5.9 miles.
