

Qualifying Criteria for Overnight Outing Selection

Minimum Contribution Required to Qualify for an Overnight Trip:

Be a CCHC member for the 12-month period prior to the opening sign-up date.

During that 12-month period EITHER:

- 1.) Serve on the CCHC Board
- 2.) Serve as Extracurricular Coordinator, Printer, or Mailer
- 3.) Serve as a Sunday or Thursday Hike Scheduler
- 4.) Serve on a CCHC Committee
- 5.) Serve as the Hike Attendance Coordinator for hikes

OR Complete at least 2 of the following:

- 1.) Lead/Co-lead an Overnight Hike Trip
- 2.) Lead/Co-lead Thursday or Sunday Hike
- 3.) Contribute hike write-ups, photos or articles PUBLISHED in groups.io

OR

Participate in 18 hikes/year.

Newer members with at least one-year membership are eligible for outings as space allows.

Participant Requirements

If two or more Hike Leaders find an attendee to have exhibited behaviors that have negatively impacted any hike, such as:

- a) An unrealistic assessment of his/her own physical abilities.
- b) The inability to follow the directions of the hike leaders and carpool drivers.
- c) Lack of cooperation in coordinating with other members to foster a successful event for everyone.

d) ANY BEHAVIOR that jeopardized the health or safety of the individual or other members.

An Incident Report on this attendee must be brought to the attention of the Board of Directors.

The Board of Directors may exclude the individual from future outings for a period of 12 months. The Board of Directors will notify the person in question of the exclusion via a signed letter with right of appeal to the Board.

CLARIFICATIONS:

- 1.) The Overnight Trip will be announced in a 2-week window for sign-ups.
- 2.) Members must have their dues paid up 12 months prior to the opening sign-up date to qualify.
- 3.) If more than the maximum number allowed on the trip happen to sign-up, a lottery will be used to determine who is selected from a list of those who qualify. The Overnight Outing Committee will confirm who meets the qualifying criteria. Those not selected will be placed on a "priority waiting list". Those who signed up but did not qualify will be placed on a secondary list and may attend if there are openings.
- 4.) Members must qualify on their own merit.
- 5.) A list of names will be sent to all who were selected with instructions on how to make reservations. Selectees will have an opportunity to request a roommate from the list, if desired.
- 6.) Applications received post signup may be considered if space becomes available.
